

## ELIGIBILITY SEA (SERVICE EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITY)

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Completed *Virginia State Surplus Property* application
- Detailed narrative description (brochure) about your organization including number of troops in a council or scouts in a troop, location, description of activities or services provided, staff information (if applicable), etc.
- Current charter, certificate or other documentation showing affiliation with your national organization or office. (*Annual updates are required for all charters and certifications with expiration dates*).

*Schools with military training programs (such as military junior colleges, military institutes, high schools which host a Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps unit or a National Defense Cadet Corps unit, naval honor schools, and state maritime academies) should contact their sponsoring military services for obtaining surplus property.*

*Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts and Red Cross chapters should contact their regional or national headquarters for guidance regarding the use of DoD surplus property.*
